EIGHTH GRADE

General Supplies:

Two 2-inch 3-ring loose-leaf binders with tab dividers

An inexpensive binder-style 3-hole punch

Three packages of sticky notepads – 2" x 2" **and** 1" x 1" (any brand)

Metric / Standard Ruler – with holes for insertion in binder

Index cards -3" x 5", lined (500 cards)

Scissors

Glue sticks

Earbud headphones with a microphone

Graph paper – ¼" Grid

Algebra: Two 3-subject notebooks (8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11"), and two folders **Math:** One 3-subject notebook (8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11"), and two folders

Earth Science Regents: Barron's Blue Book Current Edition, and one 3-subject notebook (8 ½"x11")

General Science: One 2-inch 3-ring loose-leaf binder

ELA: One composition notebook, and one 1-inch 3-ring loose-leaf binder with tab dividers

World Languages: One 3-subject notebook (8 ½" x 11"), and one 2-pocket folder
